The Migrant Workers' Project was run by Glamorgan GATES with photographer, Toril Brancher
Between 2005 and 2006, Glamorgan GATES gave disposable cameras to people who had come from elsewhere to live and work in Merthyr Tydfil.

We met people in cafes, the college and on the street. The only instruction people were given was that they must always use the flash!

Almost 100 people took part in the project. The resultant images showed a very different Merthyr Tydfil than the traditional black and white images we usually see.

The images were shown in small exhibition spaces around Merthyr Tydfil, in Wrexham Art Gallery and in The Senedd.
